

HOW CAN I HEAR THE CHESHIRE PUBLIC LIBRARY PODCAST ON iTUNES?

Download & install iTunes 6.0 software

<http://www.apple.com/itunes/download/>

note: iTunes is free software for the Mac or PC. You must have iTunes version 4.9 or above to access the podcast directory. Earlier versions of iTunes do not support podcasts.

Open the iTunes Music Store

- Open the iTunes software
- In the "source column" on the far left, click on "Music Store."
- The software will connect to the Internet and open the online Music Store in the main iTunes window.

Find the Cheshire Public Library Podcast in the Podcast Directory

- Find the lefthand column headed "Inside the Music Store."
- Under "Inside the Music Store," click on "Podcasts."
- Scroll down the podcasts page until you see a search box on the left hand side.
- Type "Cheshire Public Library Podcast" and click enter.

Listen or Subscribe

- Double-click on the "CheshirePublicLibraryPodcast" listing for a short sample.
- Click the "Subscribe" button to download the whole episode to your computer.
- Listen off-line by clicking on the downloaded episode. All episodes will appear in the "podcasts" section of your music library.

To hear future episodes

- Open iTunes.
- Open the "Podcasts" area of your iTunes music library (purple icon) and click on the "Update" icon in the upper right-hand corner. iTunes will then check the Music Store to see whether new episodes have been released. New episodes will then automatically be downloaded to your computer.

Troubleshooting Tips:

If you find yourself lost within the iTunes Music Store, the icon shaped like a little house will always bring you home—i.e. to the main iTunes page. The arrow keys to the left of the "home" icon function like arrow keys on web browsing software. Use them to go backward or forward through pages.
